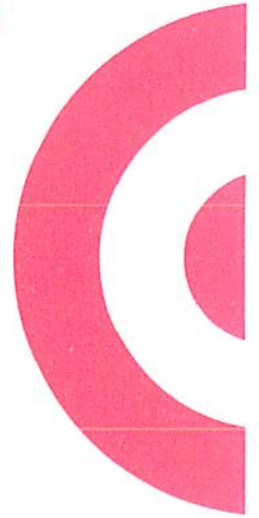


HELP US HELP OUR SCHOOL.
