The FBI Youth Academy at Miami Dade College North Campus is a prestigious learning community geared towards educating high school students about the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Miami Dade College's School of Justice degree programs, and other related Law Enforcement Careers.

The Academy is designed to educate South Florida high school students about the inner workings of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), opportunities available at the Miami Dade College School of Justice, and various local law enforcement career prospects. The FBI Youth Academy affords students a unique opportunity to engage collaboratively with FBI agents, law enforcement personnel, and university professors that foster leadership skills, critical thinking, and team building.

Students gain a full awareness of the required education and training for specific careers with the FBI and general law enforcement agencies. Conducted on the 245-acre Miami Dade College-North Campus, students take part in a diverse schedule that includes formal instruction, scenario-based training, and practical applications. Students are fully immersed in hands-on modules that include mock crime scene investigations, SWAT led hostage recovery, and other activities that emphasize expert investigation techniques.
