The Florida Marlins would like to invite your school, grades 3-8, to an exciting science field trip on **Wednesday, April 27, 2011**. The **5<sup>th</sup> Annual CBS 4 Weather Day with the Florida Marlins** will begin at 10:15 AM at Sun Life Stadium. This educational program will touch upon various weather related topics, relevant to living here in South Florida and will follow the *Sunshine State Standards*. Upon the conclusion of the forty-five minute program, your Florida Marlins will host the Los Angeles Dodgers at 12:10 PM.

The CBS 4 Weather Team and other special guests will give your students a unique opportunity to be a part of a fun and exciting program in which they will learn about hazardous weather including thunderstorms, lightning, tornados and hurricanes. In addition, meteorology, math, science, computer science and geography will all be touched upon.

Enclosed you will find all the information for the field trip including the ticket order form. This event averages approximately 10,000 students in attendance so we ask that you make your reservation today. Reserving your school is easy. Just follow these simple steps:

Please make your reservation with the deposit by **Wednesday, March 9, 2011**. **(All schools who have submitted their deposits by March 9, 2011 will be entered into a random drawing to win volunteer opportunities for some of your students, prizes, and more!**
3. After making your reservation, collect the field trip money from your students and chaperones and mail the completed form with the final ticket quantity and final payment to the Marlins. The deadline to submit your school's final headcount and payment is prior to the FCAT on **Friday, April 1, 2011**.

This field trip is about leaving the confines of the classroom to observe on a firsthand basis and provides your students a real-world view of weather.
